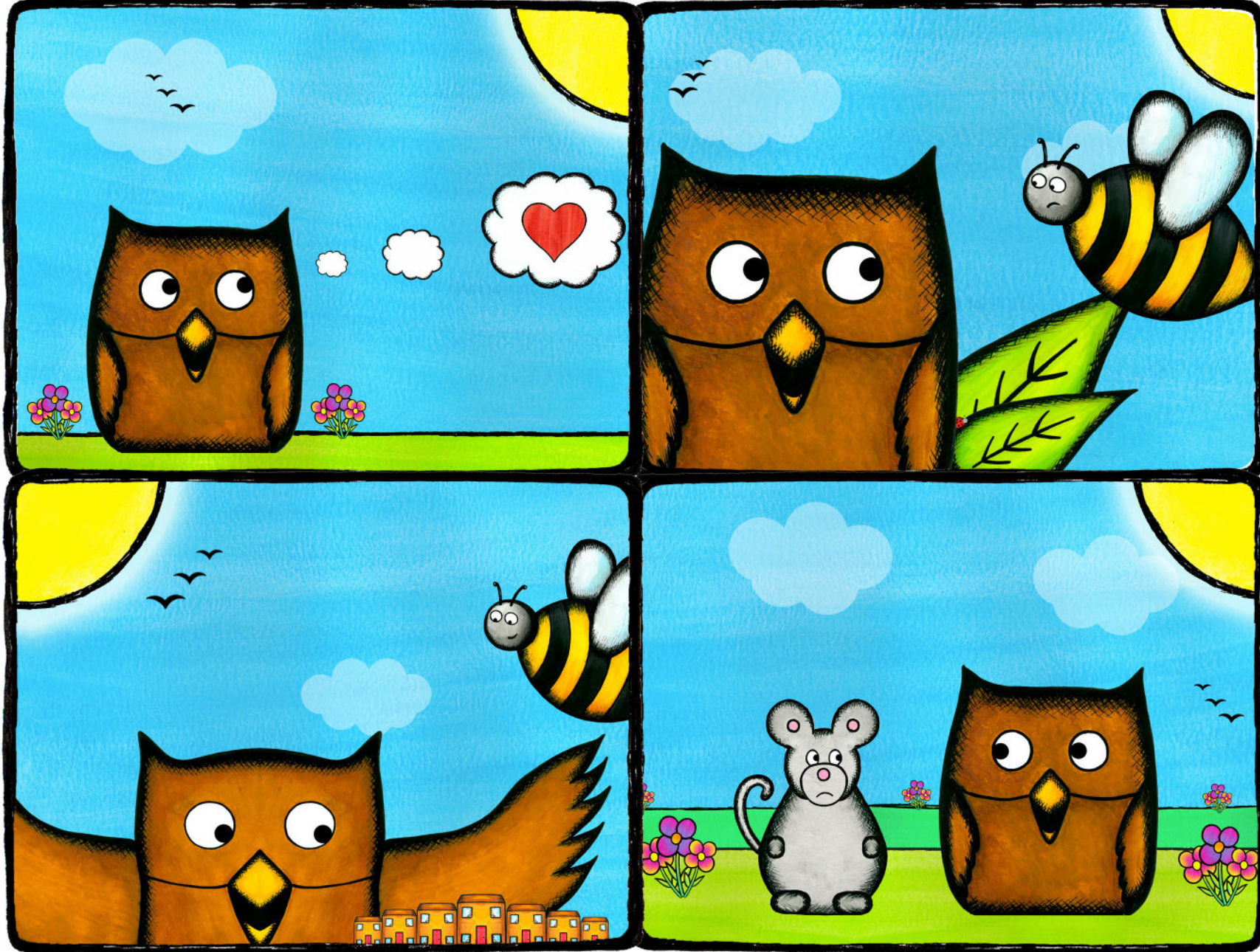
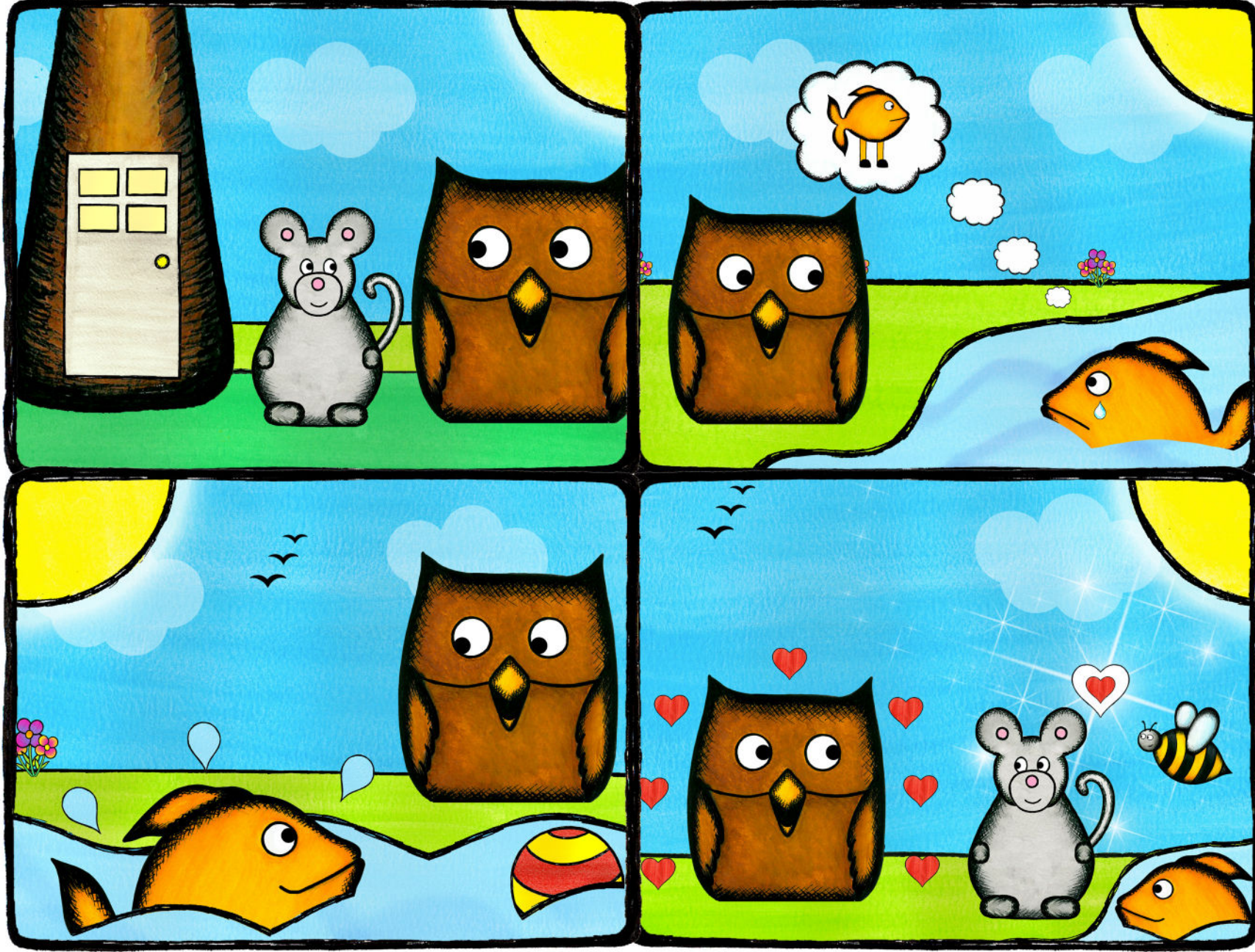




Oaky Owl Story Sequence Cards
